- Q: Is there an opportunity for you to develop your own grounds at Whitehaugh?
- A: No, not enough land for cricket and hockey
- **Q:** What about car parking for school?
- A: Unchanged in terms of arrangements and increased car parking too
- Q: Football currently very busy and grass facility is poor.
- A: We would fix the drainage Also, have asked RLL - if hockey in Ralston, do they have somewhere fir football to go to eg racecourse/new PGS site (Resident responded, so you'd be taking football away from here) Later point - there's no money in budget for grass pitch drainage

- Q: For the gardens backing on to the grass pitches what are the plans re fencing / netting?
- A: We would know what to do from a fencing point of view. Later in the meeting: Fencing would be pushed back and as high as possible, nearer Buchlyvie Road
- Q: Are you planning to have license bar?
- A: It's not in our business plan. It will be a social area and we plan to remove 2 changing areas
  This was questioned later: wouldn't we need more changing areas?
  Response Consideration to building more
  NB This is phase 1 a license could be applied for at any time

- Q: When discussions (about KHC taking Ralston) start ?
- A: Approx 2015. The Council approached us.
- **Q:** Could both be built?
- A: Yes but the cost would be up to £1.8 million. The budget is £600k We are happy to consider a separate football pitch, even an additional CAT NB traffic/car parking considerations
- **Q:** Been told the current pitch is end of life?
- A: Actually has 3 years. Maintenance currently required
- Q: What if you don't get charitable status?
- A: Would need to do it differently

- Q: Where are you getting the money?
- A: Response not detailed, see notes in presentation. The centre would need to generate £30k
- Q: Will Auchmannoch Road gated area be utilised for traffic?
- A: Potentially. We don't know how much football will be played yet

Ralston Primary Head supports this' -But, a resident said 'parents didn't know this/weren't in that place

- Q: Have you spoken to football clubs about playing on grass?
- A: Yes. One the other night.
- **Q: Will there be more lights?**
- A: No NB won't be able to play till 9.30 pm per presentation

**Points:** 

- Concern over traffic
- Would like to see business plan
- Would like to see financials
- Would like to see the CAT
- AND Ralston skills will cease

Final point from a resident:

- I think the existing pitch should stay
- You need to sort funds for anything additional
- Not sure how much use the community will get with two pitches
- Too many ifs, buts and maybes
